The war has displaced 5.9 million people inside the country. 6.4 million people from Ukraine left their homes and are still staying abroad. 14.6 million Ukrainians require multisectional humanitarian aid. Humanitarian needs multiply and spread by the hour as the crisis continues to develop.

We have experienced the impact of connection, identity building, Jewish ritual, and now we are witnessing the power of global response to the crisis.

Applying for Tikkun Olam Grant is one way to help amplify the response to the increasing need for humanitarian aid and crisis relief. Houses, Pods, and MHWOW hosts can apply for up to \$75 per direct service Tikkun Olam program, and for up to \$50 for educational programs to support the global Ukrainian refugee crisis.

HERE ARE A FEW IDEAS FOR YOUR TUKKUN OLAM PROGRAM:



Invite Ukrainians to share their stories during the Shabbat - give space for testimonials and bring real-life stories to your community.



Reach out to the Moishe House Ukrainian staff or residents and give them a platform to spread the awareness and voice their vision of what's going on.



Direct Service – a hands-on service (volunteering) project that directly meets the material needs of Ukrainian refugees.



Partner with a local organizations supporting Ukrainians and ask what they need. Service is best done in partnership.
